OBJECTIVES OF EIA STUDY

The main objectives of the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) is to ensure that the environmental problems arising from development of the Project are foreseen and addressed at an early stage in the project planning and design.

OBJECTIVES OF EIA STUDY

1

To describe the existing environmental and resource use, based mostly on existing data from the description of the project information and other reports relating to the physical, ecological resources, land use and quality of life values relevant to the proposed project areas.

To review, identify and assess the major environmental impacts that may result from the project development on the basis of information collated from existing sources and on supplementary information collected in the field.

To suggest mitigating measures that can eliminate or minimize deleterious impacts of project development and propose plans for surveillance and monitoring of environmental effects.

To discuss the environmental significance of potential residual impacts.
